- Watercolor Paints
 - Lemon yellow
 - Alizarin crimson
 - Cerulean blue
 - Lamp black
 - Yellow ochre
 - Cadmium yellow
 - Cadmium red
 - Ultramarine blue
 - Burnt sienna
 - Burnt umber

A great starter set is [Winsor & Newton Cotman Water Colour Paint Sketchers' Pocket Box](#)

- Watercolor Paper (9"x12"), such as [Canson XL Series Watercolor Pad](#)
- Watercolor Brushes
 - 1 bamboo brush, such as [I-MART Chinese Calligraphy Brush, Writing Brush, Japanese Sumi-e Drawing/Painting Brush](#) (This is a set, but you only need one.)
 - 1 Flat watercolor wash brush, such as [Princeton Series 4350 Synthetic Watercolor & Acrylic Brushes 3/4 in. Stroke](#)
- Palette (for holding paint; a plastic plate is OK)
- Paper Towels
- Sponge
- Small Tub (for holding water and wetting sponge)
- Spray Bottle (for water)
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Toothbrush
