

Watercolor Snacks: Pear Materials and Tools

All materials can be purchased from any art store, such as [Cheap Joe's](#), [Blick](#), [Michael's](#), etc., or on [Amazon.com](#). *If you purchase your supplies in-person from Cheap Joe's, bring proof of your workshop registration, and you'll receive a 10% discount!*

Paint

Student grade or better pan watercolor set

For the pear workshop, we'll be using:

- Lemon yellow
- Cadmium yellow (medium or other)
- Sap green
- Dark brown

Notes:

- Avoid purchasing a craft or children's paint set.
- Set of 12 paints is recommended.

Brush

1 round watercolor brush, size 5-10

Example: [Princeton Select Paint Brush Set](#)



Note: Size 6 watercolor brush is recommended, but any size 5-10 will work.

Paper

140 lb cold press watercolor paper pad

Example: [Strathmore 300 Series Watercolor Paper Pad](#)

Notes:

- 9"x12" pad is recommended.
- The brand of paper doesn't matter as much as the weight.
- Make sure you can remove pages from the pad as you work.
