OTHER PURCHASING TIPS:

- Balance price with quality; good brushes and paints last for years.
- There's a huge variety of paper; again, quality makes a difference. Arches is recommended.

Watercolor Paint (Pictured paints are from Cheap Joe's in Asheville. Other options are available. If you already have paint, check with Terrilynn if you have questions.)



These basic colors will get you going, and you can add on as desired. There are SO many choices, start simple.

Mid yellow
Cad red
Purple Lake

Ultramarine
Cerulean
Burnt Umber

Watercolor Paper, 140lb (minimum 9"x12")



Watercolor Palette (basic one here)



Watercolor Brushes (these two to start)

- One large flat wash brush (3/4 – 1")
- One round (size 6, 8, or 10) that comes to a sharp point when wet and tapped
